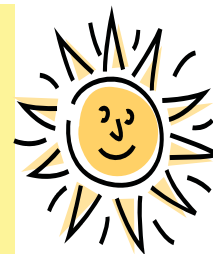

## 2009 SUMMER TENNIS PROGRAM

It is our hope that this Spring Clinic has provided fundamentals to get your child excited about the game of tennis. Currently, the Parks Department is resurfacing area tennis courts to prepare our community for a summer of fun activities. Tennis programs for youth will begin soon to provide quality instruction and to promote team play. Cost per session: \$25. Instructor - Adam Peden.

Quick Start Tennis - (ages 4 - 7 years old) - Bring kids into the game by utilizing equipment, shorter court dimensions and modified scoring while playing in a team environment.

Beginning Youth Play - (ages 8 -12 years) - As kids grow, so does the game. Kids progress from a short to a mid-sized court with age appropriate equipment and scoring.

Advanced beginners - (Ages 12 & up) - Continue to develop skills while competing in friendly matches.

## AQUATIC ACTIVITIES

Due to the opening of the new Scribner Place YMCA/New Albany-Floyd County Aquatic Center, all Parks Department summer aquatic programs have been moved into the 3 pool facility in downtown New Albany. Family Swim and Water Aerobics are available with a YMCA membership or for a daily drop in fee. A six lane lap pool, a warm water therapy pool along with a family fun pool with play features and a water slide are available for public use. The aquatic facility is the collaboration of the Horseshoe Foundation of Floyd County, City of New Albany and Floyd County. The YMCA is responsible for operating and maintaining the facility.



## SWIM TEAMS

The New Albany-Floyd County Parks Department will again be sponsoring 2 swim teams this summer for boys and girls age 6 to 18. The New Albany Swim Team (NAST) will be practicing at 9am or 10 am and the Floyd County Flying Fish (FCFF) will be practicing at 6 pm or 7 pm. Practices will be Monday-Friday beginning on June 3rd at Hazelwood Middle School. Each team will compete in 6 swim meets as well as in the 8 team Championships on July 18th. Fees are \$60 for the first child and \$50 for each additional family member. Participants must be able to swim the length of the pool (25 yards) without hanging onto the lane line.
