2010 FALL SOFTBALL LEAGUE INFORMATION**

1. Total league fee is \$300.00. **Balance of \$300.00 is due at time of registration.** No exceptions will be made. Fee has to be paid to be scheduled. Deadline for registration is **Monday, August 30, 2010.**
2. Roster/waiver is due before the first game can be played. Last date for roster changes is before third game is played. Changes can be made with the scorekeeper at your field.
3. All teams will be sanctioned U.S.S.S.A. **Teams must be sanctioned "D" or below to play in leagues.**
4. Six weeks of play, 8 games and a tournament. Each team plays two games per week. (Monday & Wednesday) or (Tuesday & Thursday)
5. The Parks Department must have at least four teams to run a league. The Parks Department reserves the right to place teams in the league.
6. U.S.S.S.A. approved game balls will be provided.
7. Rain out games will be made up:
PRIORITY WILL BE AS FOLLOWED:
 - I. - at the 9:30 game time if there is one.
 - II. - at the end of the season.
 - III. - on Friday nights.
8. **Leagues will begin the week of September 7, 2010.**
9. T-shirts will be awarded to league winners at team request. Logo/design will be chosen by Athletic Director. You may choose color of shirt. **No** special order shirts will be provided.
10. Sponsor plaques will be awarded to tournament winner at team request.
11. All checks are deposited daily. Any returned checks will be subject to a **returned check fee (\$25)**. If a team drops from the league before the league starts, a refund will be issued if another team can be found to replace that team. If another team cannot be found, half the fee will be refunded. No refund will be issued after the start of the season. The refund will be issued in four to six weeks.
12. All players participating in the NA-FC Department of Parks and Recreation Softball Leagues must sign the roster/waiver provided by the Parks Department. This waiver must be signed before any player can take the field and participate in any game situation.
13. All communication will be by email unless short notice then by cell phone.
